

Georgia Soccer Scholarship Application Form

What: \$1000 scholarships will be awarded based on academic and extra-curricular achievement. Who: The awards are open to high school seniors participating in a Georgia Soccer program in the current seasonal year as a player, referee, coach, or volunteer and planning to attend a 2 or 4-year college or university beginning with the Fall semester. Criteria: Applicants should have exemplary academic and extra-curricular histories. Deadline: All applications and supporting documents must be received by June 9. Awards: Recipients will be chosen and notified by July 20 with awards paid to the receiving institution by August 15.

The submission must contain the following to be considered:

- Application form
- **OFFICIAL** High School Transcript
- Copy of SAT and/or ACT scores
- College or university letter of acceptance
- Letter of Recommendation (Rich Freeman Scholarship only)
